Show safe in fitted location



Show all locking points inside safe door and the separate lockable ammunition container



Show all anchor points. A minimum of two anchorage bolts into two separate immovable surfaces ie floor and wall is required



Clearly show the size of the washers by using a ruler for scale

### Things to consider when installing your safe

- The cabinet or container is to be securely anchored from the inside at 2 points on each of 2 separate surfaces to 2 immovable structural surfaces by means of 8 mm x 75 mm masonry fixing bolts or coach screws, as is appropriate.
- At each anchor point the cabinet or container is to be reinforced with a minimum of 40 mm x 40 mm x 2 mm metal plate, or a 40 mm x 2 mm metal washer, fitted between the surface of the cabinet or container and the head of the bolt or coach screw.
- The cabinet or container is to sit flush against all surfaces it is attached to with any skirting boards behind the cabinet or container removed. If skirting cannot be removed, the gap must be filled completely with a material such as a length of wood.
- If the cabinet or container is installed inside a suitable shed or sea container and the bolts protrude externally, cuphead bolts must be used through the structural beam with the nuts and washers installed inside safe.
- A separate lockable ammunition cabinet or container is required which is securely affixed so as to prevent its removal from the cabinet or container.
