- Club Constitution. Include your Statement of Purpose, your adopted Rules of Incorporation and your structure;
- · Club Rules/By-Laws;
- · Shooting Disciplines;
- Club Membership Total number of regular members and a comprehensive list of Committee Members including Roles; and
- Firearm Range Details Details of Approved Firearm Range or Memorandum of Understanding with the holder of an Approved Firearm Range.

PLEASE NOTE: Not all Shooting Clubs have their own Firearm Range and may enter into a lease agreement with another Shooting Club to use their Approved Firearm Range to conduct their shooting events
