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### What is an administrator?

1. The State Administrative Tribunal decides if a person needs an administrator.
2. An administrator is a person who can make financial and property decisions for a person with a decision-making disability.
3. Financial and property decisions can be about money, selling things or paying bills.
4. An administrator does not make lifestyle decisions.
5. Often a family member or friend is someone's administrator.
6. If these people are not available, the Public Trustee can be appointed.
7. Administrators work at the Public Trustee, they can also be called Trust Managers.
8. A Trust Manager working at the Public Trustee office can be contacted on 1300 746 212.
9. You can ask for an interpreter.

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
