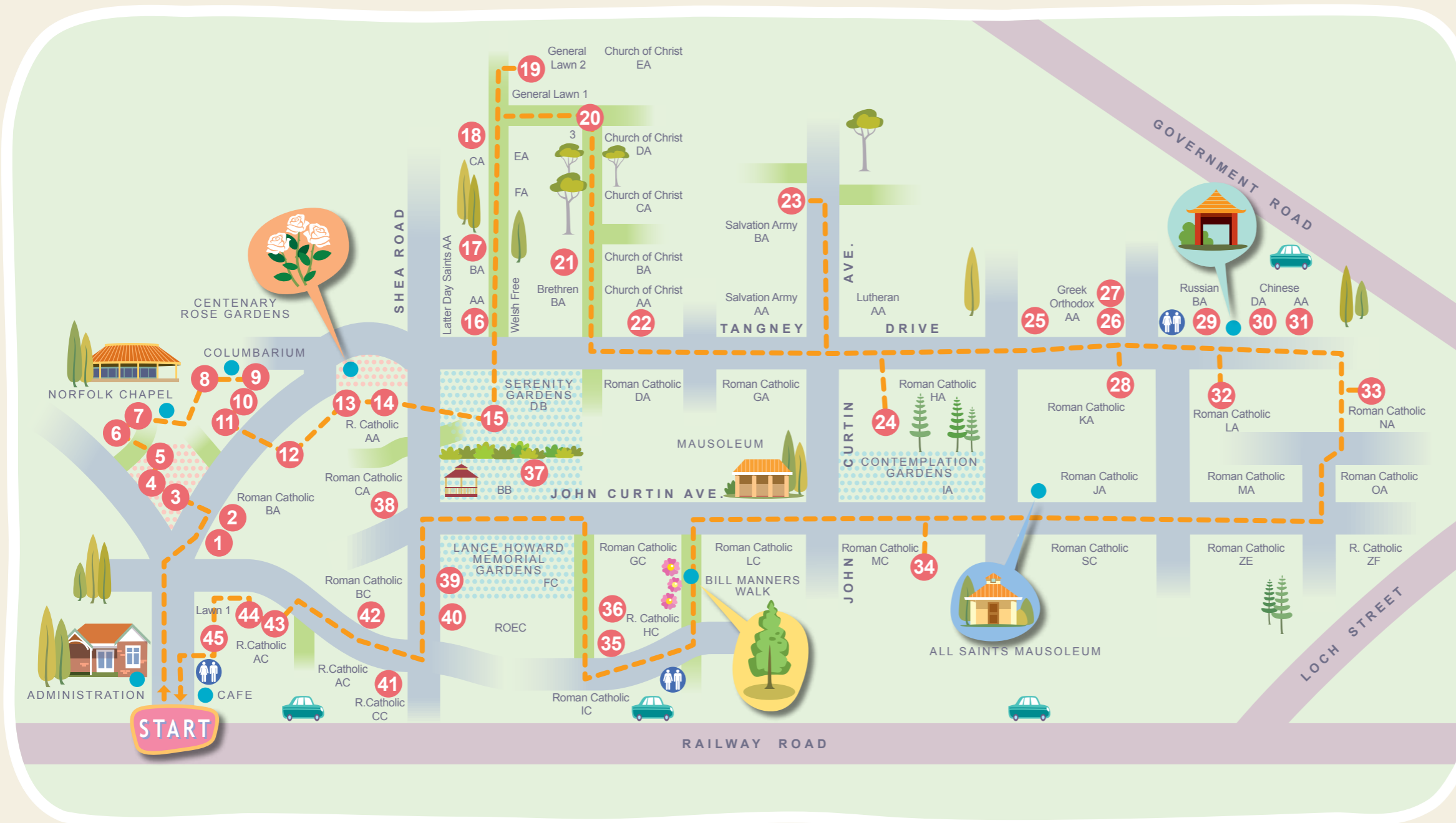


# KARRAKATTA HISTORICAL Walk Trail Two

Explore the rich history of Karrakatta Cemetery, the largest cemetery in Western Australia. The graves of some of WA's most fascinating figures are located here and feature in the walk trails. Trail Two is approximately two kilometres long and takes around two and a half hours to complete.

The easiest way to follow the trail is to use this map to follow the route. Proceed down the driveway from the main entrance to the first gravesite. Each point of interest is identified with Historical Trail signage and a grave number. If you have a smartphone or tablet computer be sure to take it along so you can scan the QR codes at each location.



To access detailed biographical information as you follow the trail, scan the QR code on the sign at each location using a smartphone or tablet computer with QR reader software installed.
