KEEP YOUR BIKE SAFE WITH THESE EASY STEPS.



Secure storage

- Keep your bicycle in a garage or locked shed when not in use.
- Use your 'D lock' and ensure it's tightly secured.
- Secure your bike so it can't be picked up and carried away.

Recording identifying details on your bike

- Help the police return recovered bicycles by creating a free profile on bikelinc.com.au or scanning the QR code.
- Record serial numbers and purchase details for your family's bicycles.

When out in public

- Lock your bicycle when not riding.
- Avoid leaving your bicycle unattended in public areas for long periods.

Going away on holidays?

- Secure your bicycle inside your house, shed, or garage.
- If you are taking your bike with you, keep it secure and out of public view when not in use.
