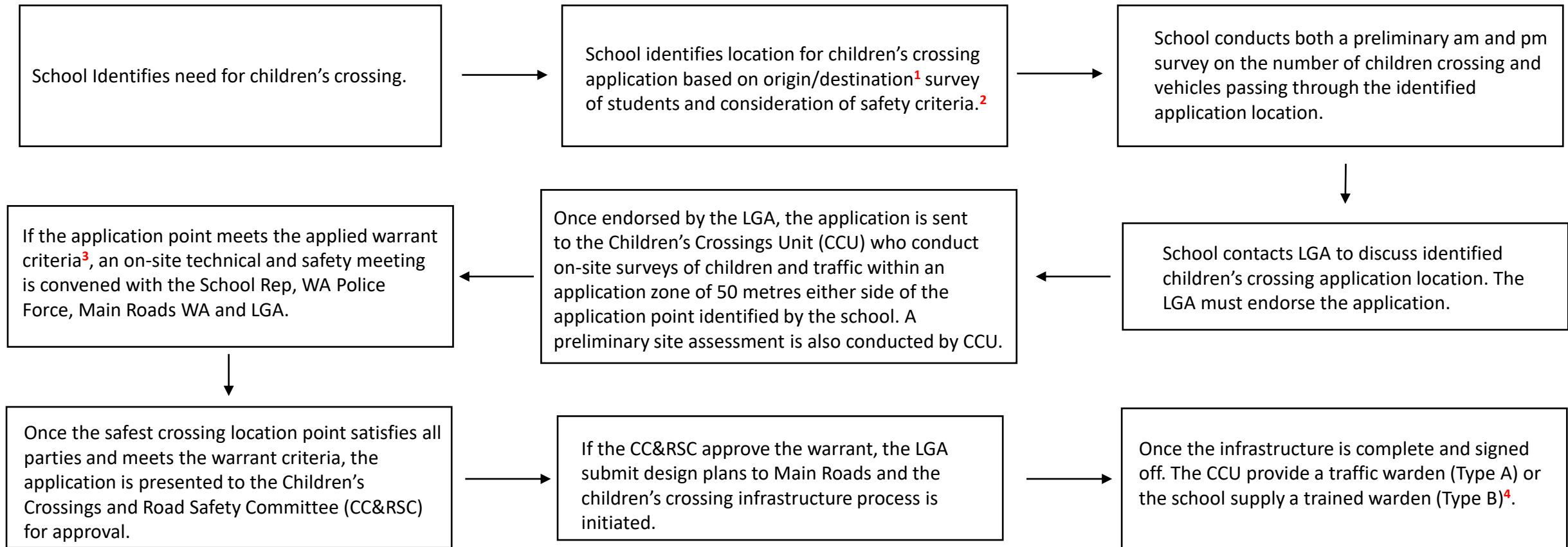


Children's Crossing Application Flow Chart



1. Pathways or common routes to and from school from surrounding areas.
2. Safety criteria refers to location of school crossing relative to intersections, roundabouts, driveways, car parks, bus stops, parking bays, adequate lines of sight, road curvature, pathway access and other identified issues that may impact the safety of the crossing.
3. Warrant Criteria
 - (i) Type A Warrant (Primary only and K-12 = 20 students and 200 vehicles)
 - (ii) Type A Warrant (High School only = 20 students and 700 vehicles)
 - (iii) Type B Warrant (Primary only and K-12 = 10 students and 100 vehicles)
 - (iv) Type B Warrant (High School only = 10 students and 350 vehicles)
4. Type B traffic wardens must be trained by the CCU.

Note: Children's crossings applications are only accepted from the School Principal or chair of the School Board/Parent Body.
