Family Violence Service

Family Violence is violence or the threat of violence by a person towards a family member or any other behaviour that coerces or controls the family member or causes the family member to be fearful.

Family Violence can include behaviours such as physical and sexual abuse, stalking, emotional or psychological abuse, pet abuse, financial abuse, social isolation. The behaviour does not necessarily have to be a physical assault.
