
Employment


Western Australia

- Seasonally adjusted employment in Western Australia increased by 0.5% to 1,361,744 during January.
- Full-time employment rose by 1,456 persons during the month while part-time employment rose by 5,238 persons.
- Employment rose by 1.1% in annual average terms and grew by 0.1% over the three months to January 2020. Full-time employment contributed 0.7 percentage points to annual growth, while part-time employment contributed 0.4 percentage points.
- In less volatile trend terms, employment was unchanged between December and January, and rose by 1.1% in annual average terms.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted employment rose by 0.1% to 12,995,437 during January.
- Full-time employment rose by 46,219 persons while part-time fell by 32,687 persons during the month.
- Employment grew by 2.3% in annual average terms and increased by 0.4% in the three months ending in January. Full-time employment contributed 1.6 percentage points to annual growth, whilst part-time employment made a 0.7 percentage point contribution.





- Over the year to January, the largest increase in seasonally adjusted employment by State was 3.3% in Victoria. The smallest increase was 0.6% in Tasmania.
- Australia's trend employment rose by 0.2% between December and January, and grew by 2.3% in annual average terms.

Unemployment Rate

Western Australia

- The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Western Australia increased to 5.8% during January 2020, up from a rate of 5.4% in December.
- The unemployment rate averaged 5.8% over the year to January 2020, which is lower than the 6.3% average unemployment rate recorded over the year to January 2019.
- The trend unemployment rate was unchanged at 5.7% in January 2020, and averaged 5.9% over the 12 months to January.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate rose to 5.3% during January 2020, up from a rate of 5.1% in December. The unemployment rate averaged 5.2% over the year, which compares to an average rate of 5.3% over the 12 months to January 2019.
- The highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate by State was 6.3% in Queensland. The lowest was 4.5% in New South Wales.
- The national trend unemployment rate was unchanged at 5.2% between December and January 2020, and averaged 5.2% over the past 12 months.


Participation Rate


Western Australia

- The seasonally adjusted participation rate in Western Australia increased to 68.2% in January 2020, up from a rate of 67.7% in December.
- The participation rate averaged 68.2% over the year to January 2020, which is lower than the 68.5% average participation rate recorded over the year to January 2019.
- The trend participation rate was unchanged at 68.1% between December and January 2020, and averaged 68.2% over the year.

Australia

 Australia's seasonally adjusted participation rate rose to 66.1% during January 2020, up from a rate of 66.0% in December. The participation rate averaged 66.0% over the year, which compares to an average rate of 65.6% over the 12 months to January 2019.
