
Employment


Western Australia

- Seasonally adjusted employment in Western Australia increased by 0.8% to 1,375,529 during February.
- Full-time employment rose by 5,668 persons during the month while part-time employment rose by 5,254 persons.
- Employment rose by 1.3% in annual average terms and grew by 0.5% over the three months to February 2020. Full-time employment contributed 0.6 percentage points to annual growth, while part-time employment contributed 0.7 percentage points.
- In less volatile trend terms, employment increased by 0.2% between January and February, and rose by 1.3% in annual average terms.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted employment rose by 0.2% to 13,015,121 during February.
- Full-time employment rose by 6,697 persons while part-time rose by 20,017 persons during the month.
- Employment grew by 2.2% in annual average terms and increased by 0.5% in the three months ending in February. Full-time employment contributed 1.5 percentage points to annual growth, whilst part-time employment made a 0.7 percentage point contribution.





- Over the year to February, the largest increase in seasonally adjusted employment by State was 3.1% in Victoria. The smallest increase was 0.9% in Tasmania.
- Australia's trend employment rose by 0.2% between January and February, and grew by 2.3% in annual average terms.

Unemployment Rate

Western Australia

- The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Western Australia decreased to 5.2% during February 2020, down from a rate of 5.7% in January.
- The unemployment rate averaged 5.8% over the year to February 2020, which is lower than the 6.3% average unemployment rate recorded over the year to February 2019.
- The trend unemployment rate was unchanged at 5.4% in February 2020, and averaged 5.7% over the 12 months to February.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate fell to 5.1% during February 2020, down from a rate of 5.3% in January. The unemployment rate averaged 5.2% over the year, which compares to an average rate of 5.2% over the 12 months to February 2019.
- The highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate by State was 5.8% in South Australia. The lowest was 4.6% in New South Wales.
- The national trend unemployment rate was unchanged at 5.1% between January and February 2020, and averaged 5.2% over the past 12 months.


Participation Rate


Western Australia

- The seasonally adjusted participation rate in Western Australia increased to 68.4% in February 2020, up from a rate of 68.3% in January.
- The participation rate averaged 68.2% over the year to February 2020, which is lower than the 68.5% average participation rate recorded over the year to February 2019.
- The trend participation rate was unchanged at 68.2% between January and February 2020, and averaged 68.2% over the year.

Australia

 Australia's seasonally adjusted participation rate fell to 66.0% during February 2020, down from a rate of 66.1% in January. The participation rate averaged 66.0% over the year, which compares to an average rate of 65.6% over the 12 months to February 2019.
