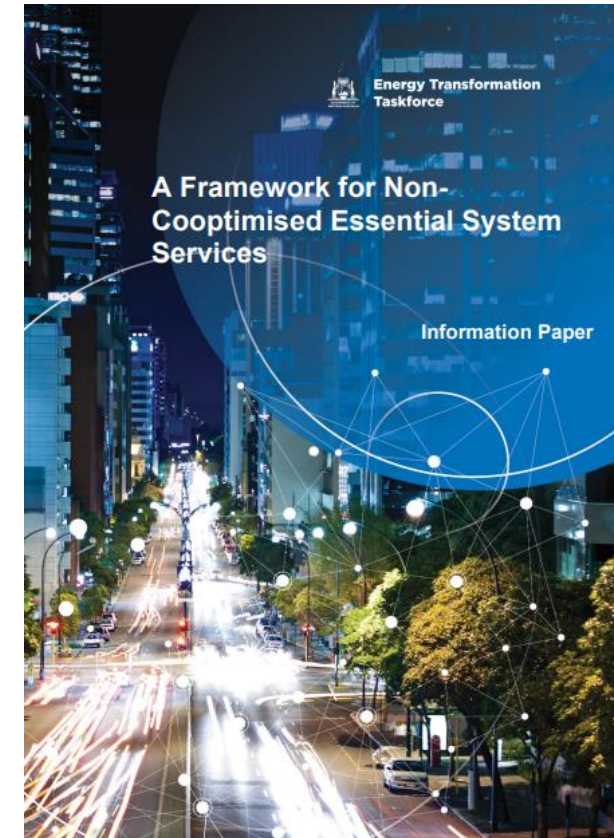

Energy Transformation Taskforce concludes

The Taskforce concluded on 19 May 2021

- last meeting was on 14 May 2021
- Final publications:
 - Market Power Mitigation
 - Non-Cooptmised ESS

Market Evolution and WEM Rule Changes

Business as usual from 1 July 2021

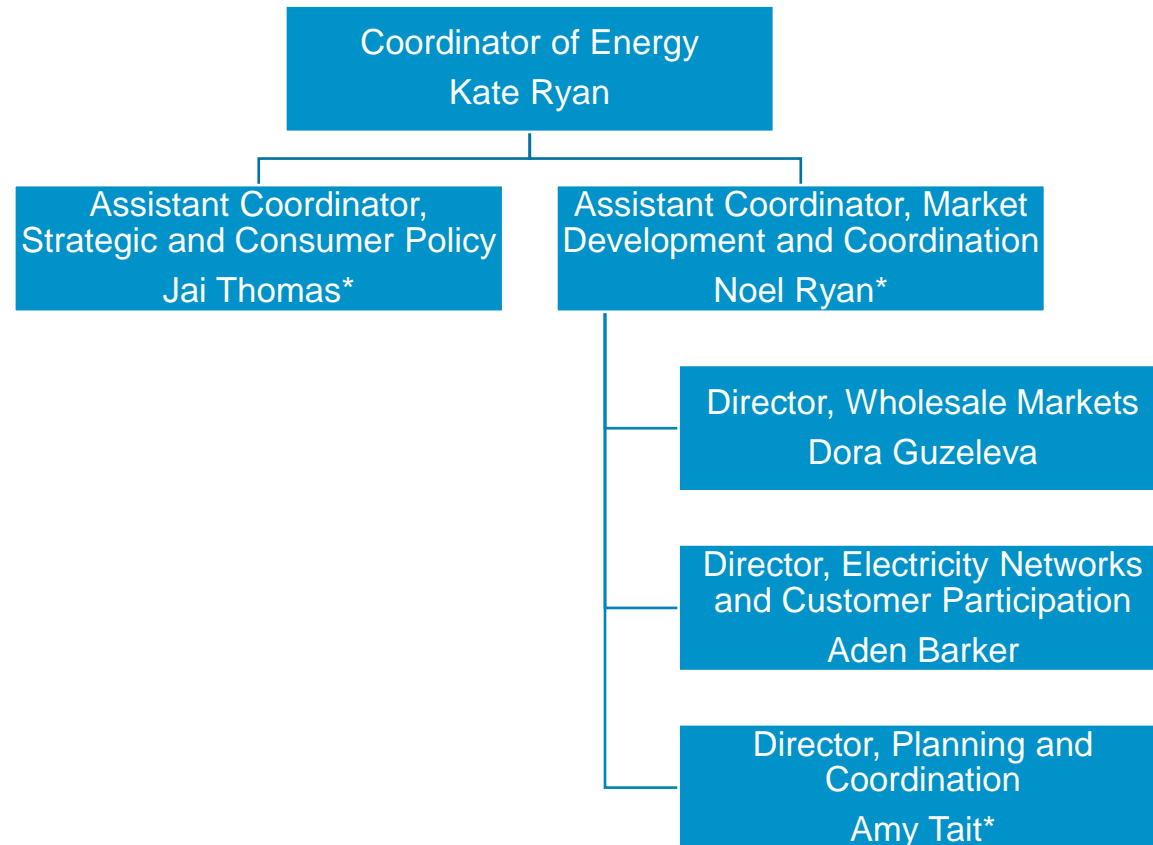
- **Implementation of new energy sector governance arrangements is now complete and will commence from 1 July 2021**
- **An independently chaired and reformed MAC will be the primary source of advice to the Coordinator of Energy on future evolution of the WEM and the resulting WEM rule changes**
 - Interim Independent Chair to be appointed soon, process for selecting a permanent chair commenced
 - Energy Policy WA is in the process of selecting two independent small consumer representatives, to be appointed by the Minister
- **The first MAC meeting after the transfer expected to be held in late July**
- **On the Agenda for the early MAC meetings:**
 - Draft changes to MAC Constitution
 - Forward work program
 - Planning for the market evolution work
