The WA Government is driving electric vehicle (EV) uptake, launching Round 3 of the Charge Up EV Charging Grants

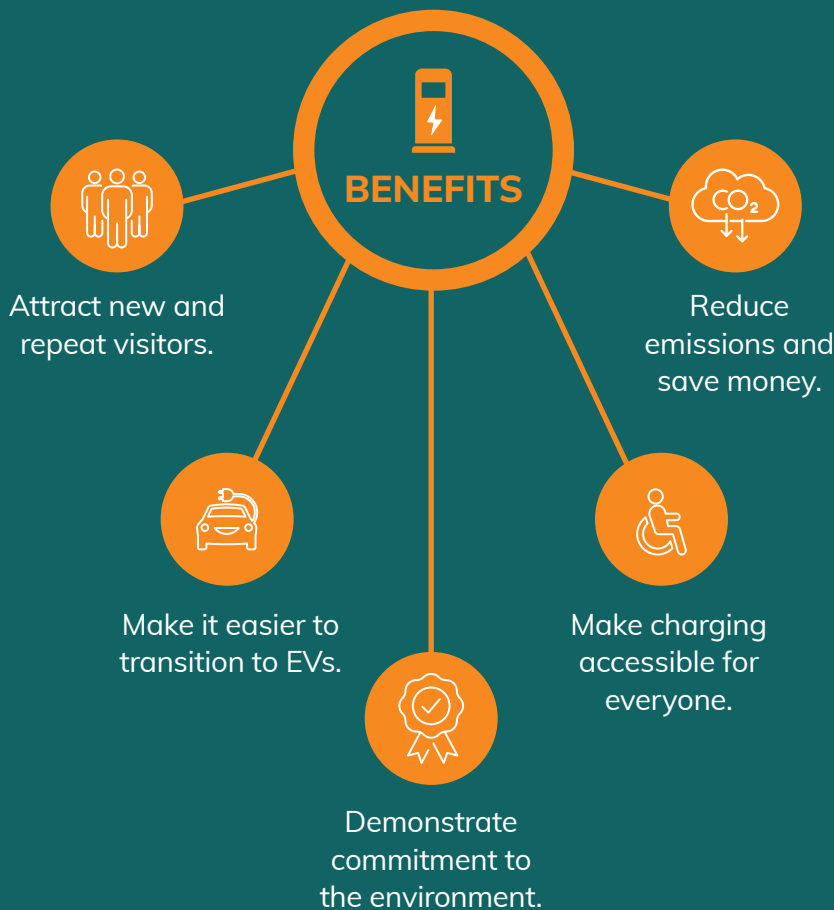
Are you eligible?

- Small to medium enterprises
- Local government authorities
- Not-for-profits

What can you get?

Charge Up provides up to 50% co-funding for eligible applicants to purchase and install EV charging infrastructure for sites in WA.

Installing chargers with Charge Up funding can provide multiple benefits



- Up to four AC/DC EV chargers per site.
- Up to five sites per applicant. Eligible sites include shared car parks and those managed by eligible charge point operators.
- Installation costs – including a two-year maintenance plan. Funding caps apply.
- Two-year software subscription.
- Network upgrades. Funding caps apply.

- Workplace Charging – fleet and employee EV

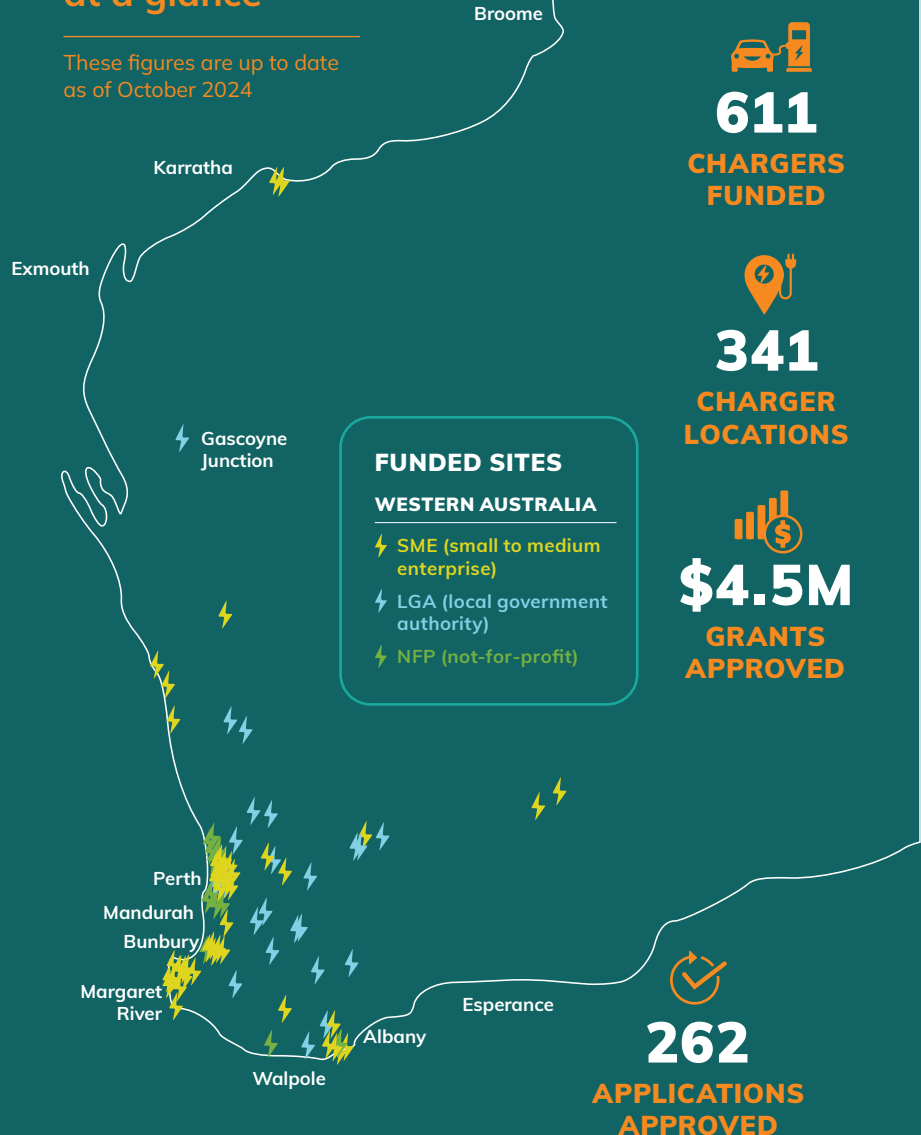
These guides will take you through the application process and help you design your project.
