

What can you get?

Charge Up provides up to 50% co-funding for eligible applicants to purchase and install EV charging infrastructure for sites in WA.



Up to four AC/DC EV chargers per site.



Up to five sites per applicant. Eligible sites include shared car parks and those managed by eligible charge point operators.



Installation costs – including a two-year maintenance plan. Funding caps apply.



Two-year software subscription.



Network upgrades. Funding caps apply.
