

Plumbing admin services at Osborne Park office cease

The Plumbers' Licensing Board (PLB) advises that plumbing administration services will no longer be provided at the Department of Commerce's Osborne Park office. Notice of Intention (NOI) books and Certificates of Compliance can no longer be purchased at this location.

Plumbers wishing to purchase NOI books and certificates over the counter in the Perth metropolitan area can do so at the Building Commission's Cannington office (details below). NOI books and certificates will continue to be available for purchase over the counter at PLB regional offices in Albany, Bunbury, Kalgoorlie, Geraldton, Karratha and Broome.
