# SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975

## REPORT VARIATION

### **PREAMBLE**

The Tribunal, on 4 October 2024, has issued a report under Section 7 of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975* (the Act) recommending an adjustment of 4%, effective from 1 December 2024 to the remuneration to be paid to Judges of the Supreme and District Courts, Masters of the Supreme Court, Magistrates and the Parliamentary Inspector of the Corruption and Crime Commission.

Registrars of the Supreme and District Courts, while included in the Special Division of the Public Service, are considered by the Tribunal within the context of Western Australia's judicial system. Consequently, this variation provides for a 4% increase to flow through to Registrars in both the Supreme and District Courts.
