Communique – 3 September 2024

The second meeting of the Directors General Technology, Innovation and Science Council (TISC) was held on 3 September 2024 at Dumas house and online via Microsoft Teams.

The TISC considered the following matters:

ServiceWA App – Payments and Rebates Capability

The TISC discussed the WA Government's ServiceWA Offers Procurement Arrangement. The WA Student Assistance Payment (WASAP) undertaken by the Office of Digital Government and the Department of Education was referred to as a prime example of a government payment which could be delivered by this new payments and rebates capability in the future.

10-year Science and Technology Plan

The Department of Jobs, Tourism, Science and Innovation (JTSI) is leading the development of a new strategic 10-year Science and Technology Plan (Plan) for Western Australia. The Plan aims to uplift science and technology capabilities in Western Australia and diversify the Western Australian economy. The TISC will oversee the ongoing implementation of the Plan. The Plan and its Framework are currently being finalised. The Plan and its Framework has been informed by key WA Government and Commonwealth agencies, community, industry and academic stakeholder groups.
