

This communique highlights key discussions and considerations from the Road Safety Council meeting held 30 August 2024.

Chair's Report

Council noted the Chair's advice regarding the Data Sharing Working Group. Data and Reports will be included as a standing item on the agenda to inform Council and assist with decision making.

Annual Report on Council's Activities

Council endorsed the draft Annual Report on Council's Activities 2023-24, which will be provided to the Minister for Road Safety to table in Parliament.

2024-25 Road Trauma Trust Account Mid-Year Review

The Council considered budget submissions for variations for existing programs and new proposals.

The Chair will write to the Minister for Road Safety, Hon David Michael MLA, advising him of the final budget recommendations.

Austrroads Road Safety Projects

Main Roads Western Australia gave a presentation on the Austrroads Mobile Point-to-Point (MP2P) cameras for speed enforcement and the Charting a Path to Zero projects.

The Mobile Point-to-Point project will develop guidelines for best-practice implementation of mobile point-to-point (P2P) cameras for managing driver speed choice. A WA Working Group has been formed to provide input regarding deployment and operational factors as well as formative and summative feedback.

The Charting a Path to Zero will provide practical guidance for all levels of government to fully implement the necessary actions to reduce fatalities and serious injuries to zero by 2050. Three workshops will be conducted to gather information regarding the level of maturity or current state of WA's approach and achievements for improving road safety
