

# SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975

## DETERMINATION VARIATION

### PREAMBLE

The Salaries and Allowances Tribunal has issued a determination to reflect changes in relation to the following offices in the Special Division of the WA Public Service and Prescribed Offices –

- Deputy Commissioner, Parliamentary Commissioner for Administrative Investigations

Given the exceptional circumstances surrounding this position, the Tribunal has agreed in this instance to back-date the Variation set out below for this position to 12 February 2024.

### DETERMINATION

#### VARIATION 1 (effective on and from 12 February 2024)

The Determination of the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal made on 22 June 2023 under sections 6(1)(c), (d) and (e) of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below, with effect on and from 12 February 2024.

Include the following clause, to appear in Part 1.1:

- (3) Where the Deputy Commissioner, Parliamentary Commissioner for Administrative Investigations, acts in the position of Commissioner, Parliamentary Commissioner for Administrative Investigations for a period of four or more consecutive weeks while the office is substantively vacant or the Office Holder is on leave, the Deputy Commissioner is entitled to receive the salary awarded in Table 2 Prescribed Office Holders, to the position of Commissioner, Parliamentary Commissioner for Administrative Investigations for the duration of the acting arrangement.

#### VARIATION 2 (effective on and from 01 July 2024)

The Determination of the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal made on 21 June 2024 under sections 6(1)(c), (d) and (e) of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below, with effect on and from 01 July 2024.

Include the following clause, to appear in Part 1.1:

- (3) Where the Deputy Commissioner, Parliamentary Commissioner for Administrative Investigations, acts in the position of Commissioner, Parliamentary Commissioner for


