DETERMINATION VARIATION

PREAMBLE

The Salaries and Allowances Tribunal has issued a determination to allow the pro rata payment of the Transition Allowance to facilitate a Member's post-Parliamentary transition, for Members of Parliament who have served less than one complete Parliamentary term.

DETERMINATION

The Members of Parliament Determination No.1 of 2024 made by the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal on 21 June 2024 under sections 6(1)(a), (ab) and (b) of the Salaries and Allowances Act 1975, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below, with effect on and from 16 December 2024.

Delete the Table in Part 7.1(5) and insert the following into Part 7.1(6):

(6) Where a Member serves less than one complete term of Parliament, they are entitled to the pro rata amount of 3 months base remuneration based upon the length of their service, as stated in Table 6.

Table 6: Transition allowance

PERIOD OF PARLIAMENTARY SERVICE	MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF BASE REMUNERATION
Less than one term of Parliament	3 months pro-rata
One term of Parliament	3 months
More than one term, but less than three terms of Parliament	6 months
Three terms of Parliament or more	9 months
