

SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975

DETERMINATION VARIATION

PREAMBLE

The Salaries and Allowances Tribunal has issued a determination to allow the pro rata payment of the Transition Allowance to facilitate a Member's post-Parliamentary transition, for Members of Parliament who have served less than one complete Parliamentary term.

DETERMINATION

The *Members of Parliament Determination No.1 of 2024* made by the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal on 21 June 2024 under sections 6(1)(a), (ab) and (b) of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below, with effect on and from 16 December 2024.

Delete the Table in Part 7.1(5) and insert the following into Part 7.1(6):

- (6) Where a Member serves less than one complete term of Parliament, they are entitled to the pro rata amount of 3 months base remuneration based upon the length of their service, as stated in Table 6.

Table 6: Transition allowance

PERIOD OF PARLIAMENTARY SERVICE	MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF BASE REMUNERATION
Less than one term of Parliament	3 months pro-rata
One term of Parliament	3 months
More than one term, but less than three terms of Parliament	6 months
Three terms of Parliament or more	9 months
